WELCOME TO SURREY REBELS INTERMEDIATE B LACROSSE

As a graduate of the Surrey Midget program, returning player from last season's Intermediate program or player who took last season off, we would like invite you to our tryout camp in February and see you wearing the orange and blue in 2010!

In 2007, we started a new program to extend the box lacrosse experience for those 16 to 18 year-old players who have graduated from the Midget ranks and either could not crack the line-up of an Intermediate A team or chose not to play in that league due to school/work commitments, travel, etc. We have had a very successful program since its inception, with teams making the playoffs in each of our first three seasons, and Rebels players named to the league All-Star Team in each of the past two seasons.

Last season saw us field a team of 25 resident Surrey players:

- 6 returnees from the 2008 Surrey Rebels Intermediate B program;
- 14 graduates of the 2008 Surrey Midget program (5 from A and 9 from B);
- 1 graduate of the 2008 Semiahmoo Midget B program;
- 2 former members of the 2008 South Fraser Stickmen Intermediate A team; and
- 2 returnees to the game after time away from Surrey Minor Lacrosse.

Together, we amassed an impressive record of 11-7-0, good for second place in the BC Intermediate Lacrosse League "B" Division, South Conference. For more information on our 2009 season achievements, visit our web page at <http://www.surreylacrosse.com/intermediate/>.

The Surrey Rebels are proud members of the BCILL "B" Division, which has teams in North Shore, Port Moody, Coquitlam, Port Coquitlam, Ridge-Meadows, New Westminster and Burnaby in the North Conference, and in Langley, Surrey, Semiahmoo, North Delta, Delta and Richmond in the South Conference. The league is sanctioned under the BCLA Senior Directorate.

The season runs from late April to late July, with typically two games per week making up an 18 game schedule. The top five teams in each conference make the playoffs, with three teams eventually advancing to the Provincial Championships. Players on our recruitment list will be contacted prior to tryout camp to confirm interest and availability. For those of you new to senior lacrosse, please note that there are a number of subtle differences over the minor (Midget and younger) ranks. Our coaching personnel and the Surrey Lacrosse Association are very committed to the development and success of the Intermediate B program, and we expect the same of all of our players.
