



## Surrey Lacrosse - Facility Access plan



- All facilities shall follow the same general guidelines
  - In Arena's –
    - No late comers, Facility Host will lock doors at the start of the booking
    - Must be on site 10 mins prior to be checked off for entry
      - Groups shall be granted access to the facility 5 mins prior to each floor time and will have 5 mins to leave the facility after the end of their floor time
    - There will be designated entry and exit locations for each facility
    - There will be no access to the change rooms
    - All Players to change in vehicles and fully equipped to play with helmet, gloves, cleats and all other required equipment shall always be equipped - no equipment bags inside
    - No in/out privileges
    - No player shall remove their Helmet (male)/ Goggles (female) / Gloves / or mouth guards while in the activity area, if it is unavoidable player must leave the activity area and physical distance as required.
    - Players shall have water bottle plus a small bag at staging locations on the sidelines or at benches ensuring physical distancing as required with cones as beacons of distance required
    - Players must do their absolute best to follow physical distancing measures until such time as this restriction is lifted, this includes
      - Must be 3 metres distanced in the field of play (surface/player benches) and 2m throughout the rest of the facility.
        - While in line ups
        - While on sidelines
        - While coming to and leaving from the activity area
        - While in activity
    - No spitting
      - Spitting or water bottle fights will NOT be tolerated. Anyone seen or found spitting on the ice, player benches or anywhere in the facility will be asked to leave the building. Evidence of spitting or water fights will be considered a breach in the Arena Re-Opening Guidelines.
    - Coaches shall have a supply of the following
      - Hand sanitizer
      - Gloves
      - Coaches shall have their own personal nonmedical face covering (mask)
    - No Spectators or parents allowed in the arenas
    - Host to escort entry and exit



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- Additional Facility Guidelines to be established by the City of Surrey & the Surrey School district.
- All membership will be required to adhere to City of Surrey guidelines, please review before your first attendance.
- All other guidelines must still be followed in accordance with WHO, PHO, PSO, & NSO
- Outside Box / and on Fields – Field / Box Lacrosse Guidelines
  - All Players to change in vehicles and fully equipped to play with helmet, gloves, cleats and all other required equipment shall always be equipped
  - No player shall remove their Helmet (male)/ Goggles (female) / Gloves / or mouth guards while in the activity area, if it is unavoidable player must leave the activity area and physical distance as required.
  - Players shall have water bottle staging locations on the sidelines ensuring physical distancing as required with cones as beacons of distance required
  - Players must do their absolute best to follow physical distancing measures until such time as this restriction is lifted, this includes
    - While in line ups
    - While on sidelines
    - While coming to and leaving from the activity area
    - While in activity
  - Fields shall be set up in a way to ensure the requirements for physical distancing is achieved.
  - Spectators must also adhere to the physical distancing measures as required by the WHO & Provincial Health Officer.
  - Coaches shall have a supply of the following
    - Hand sanitizer
    - Gloves
    - Coaches shall have their own personal nonmedical face covering (mask)
  - **Phase 3** Competitive play shall be outlined by the NSO and BCLA within the guidelines of the WHO & PSO along with ViaSport. Cohorts shall be set up to allow for competitive play but must follow the required guidelines.
- All membership will be required to adhere to City of Surrey guidelines, please review before your first attendance.
- All other guidelines must be followed in accordance with WHO, PHO, PSO, & NSO. SLA reserves the right to make adjustment to this plan as may be required.
- There will be an expectation that everyone in attendance will adhere to the requirements as laid out. Failure to do so will lead to removal from activity area and environment as may be required.
